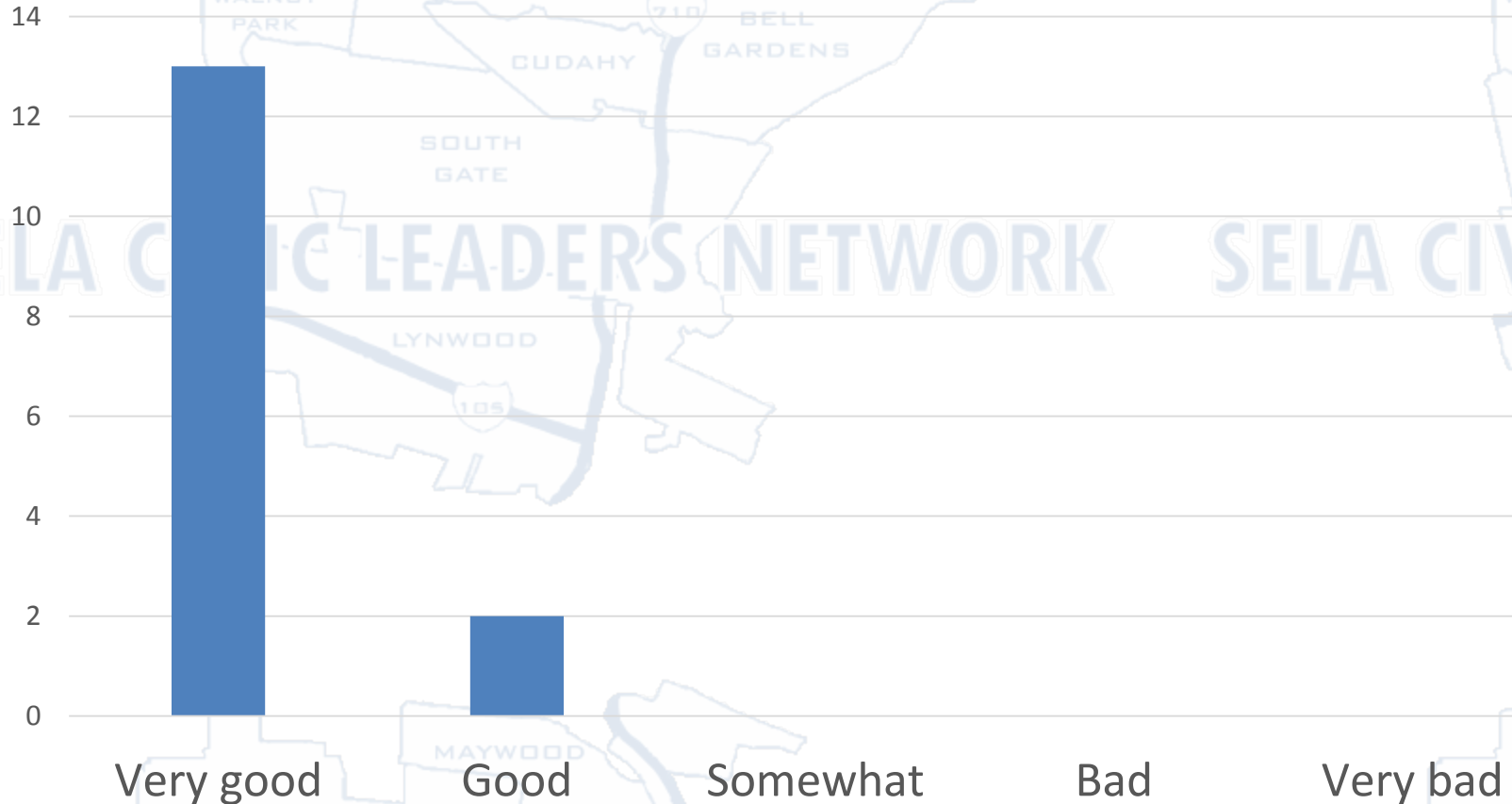
Community Survey

Background & Demographics



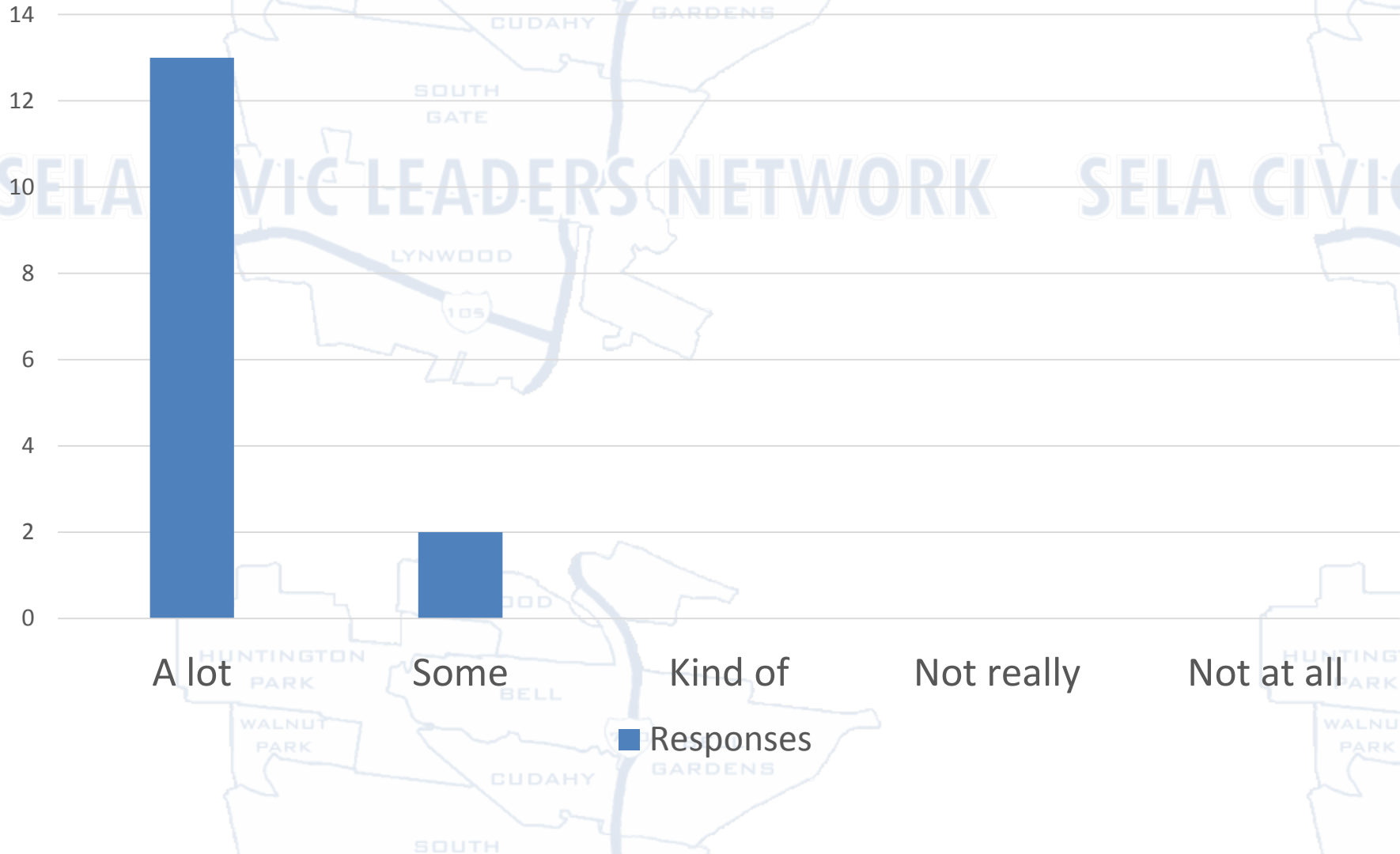
- Civic Leaders Network Southeast Los Angeles collected 15 community surveys during the event CicLAvia on Sunday May 15, 2016.

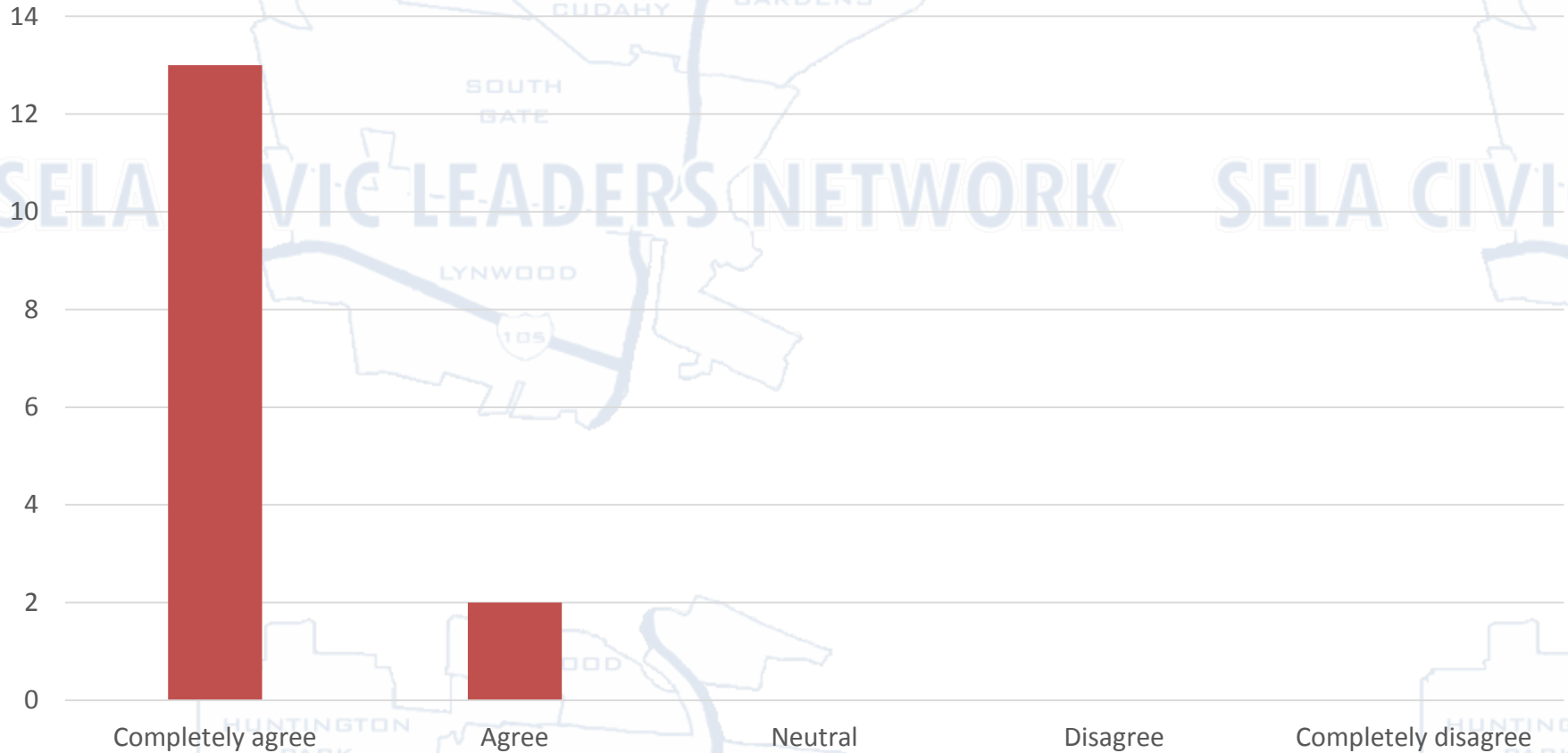
How much has my opinion of my community changed?

- Convening with family

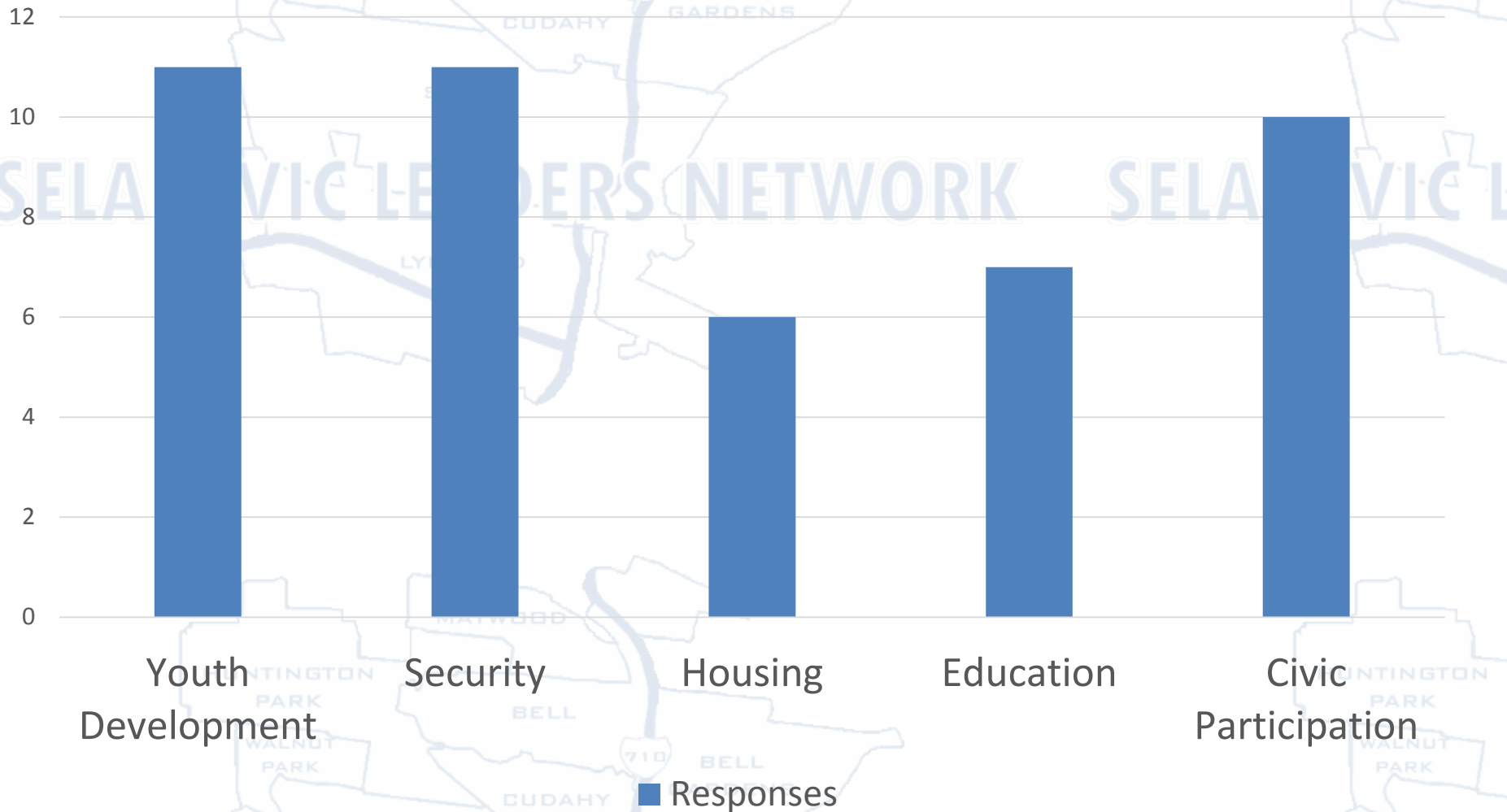
Overall, what did I like most?

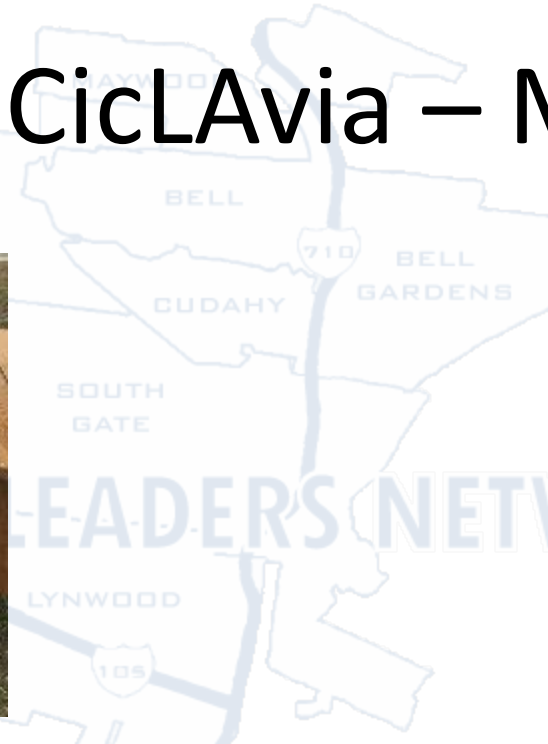

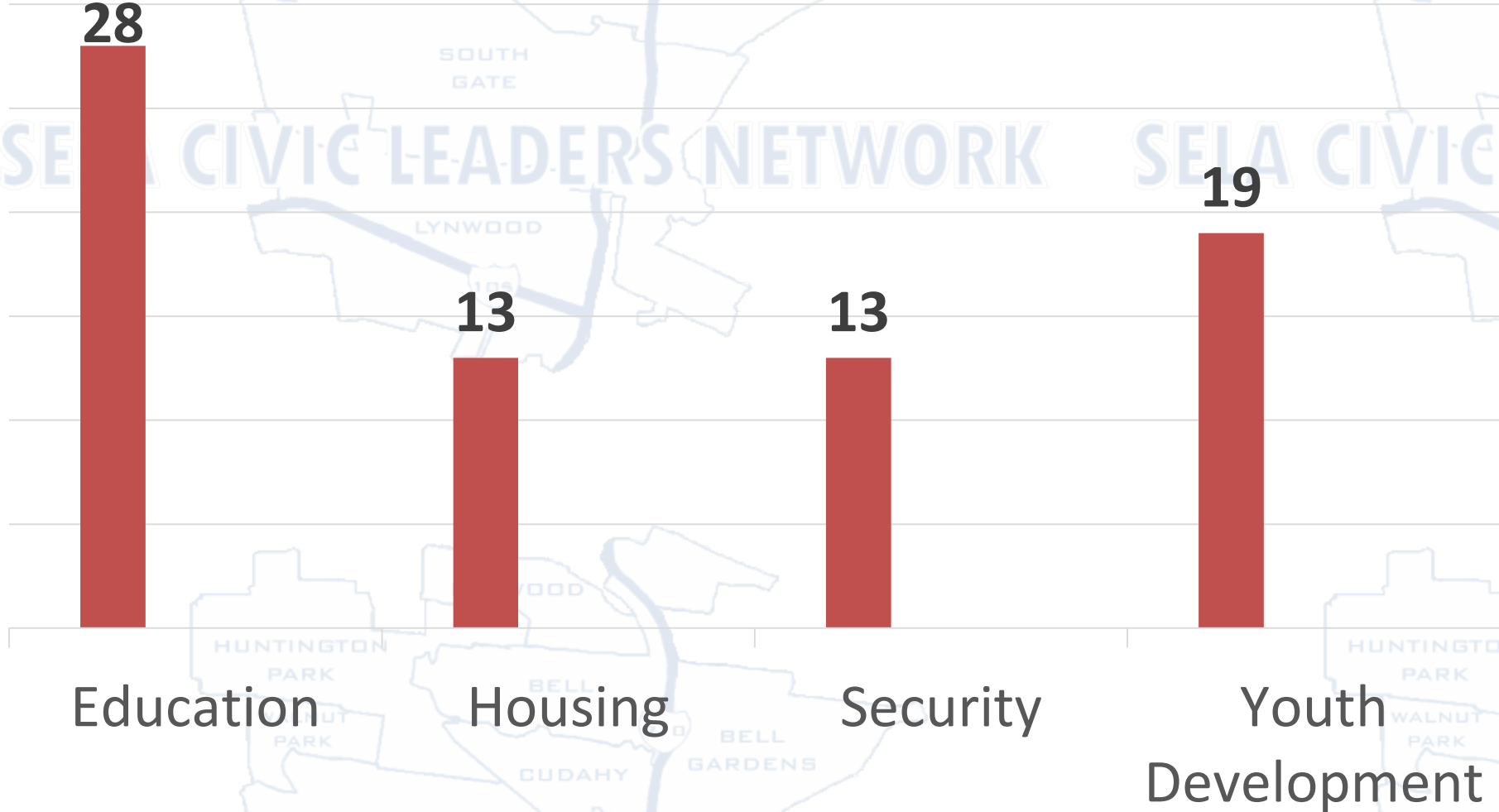

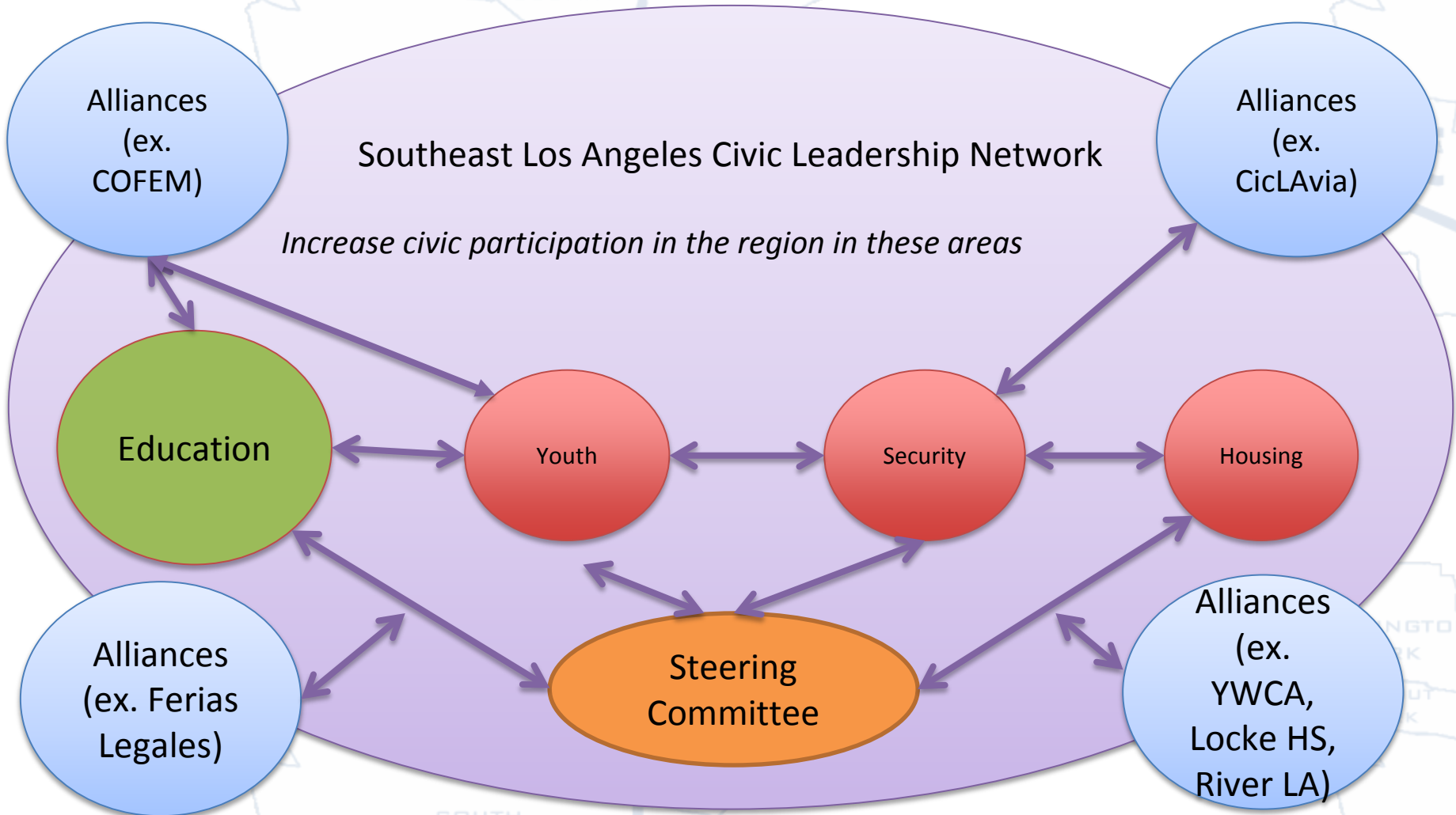
